Jackson Pollock-Inspired Action Painting



MATERIALS

- Yarn - You can also use string, straws, or any other string-like object you have at home.
- Washable paint
- Paint palette - Cups or plates work great for this!
- Painting surface - Canvas, construction paper, mixed-media paper, or anything you have available!

INSTRUCTIONS

- Cover your surface as much as possible to protect your surroundings.
- Cut yarn into 6 pieces. You will need one piece of yarn for each color you use.
- Pour paint into a paint palette, cups, or plate.
- Dip yarn (or painting utensil of your choice) into the paint.
- Use the yarn to splatter, drag, and drip the paint across your surface. Use the tools you picked in different ways to create a variety of effects on the canvas.
