Our teen groups began working with the batik process, which is a fabric dyeing technique found in many cultures around the world that uses wax as a resist. This student first painted the fabric with the bright colors, then painted the wavy lines and dots with wax. Another layer of black dye was painted over the wax, so that when the wax is removed, the first layer is revealed.
